Bunge may vary these Charges at any time as per the relevant clauses within the 2026/27 Packing & Processing Agreement. The Client acknowledges that the following Charges apply to the Client's Grain for the current Service Year and that, unless this Schedule provides otherwise, the Charges for all Grain in storage at the commencement of a new Service Year will be made at the rates applicable for that Service Year. All Charges detailed below are GST exclusive.

These Charges are effective from 1 October 2026.

D. Definitions

In this Schedule, unless the context otherwise requires:

Bagged means packed in either 25kg or 50kg bags and packed in a container.

Bulk means bulk in a container.

Cereals means Wheat, Barley and Sorghum.

Farmer Dressed means packed as received at the packing facility.

Fuel Surcharge means the fuel related costs associated with transporting the container.

Fumigation means treatment of the grain in accordance with the Importing Country requirements.

Gravity Graded means the grain is graded over a gravity table prior to packing.

Infrastructure Surcharge means the surcharge as charged by Stevedore's and Port operators.

Machine Dressed means the grain is machine cleaned prior to packing.

N/A means service is Not Available at that packing facility.

POA means price on application.

PRA means the Pre Receipt Advice required to deliver a container to the wharf.

Pulses means Broad Beans, Faba Beans, Peas, Lentils, Chickpeas and Vetch.

Rejected Empty Container means an empty container that has been rejected for packing by an Authorised Officer.

Same Day Sample means a sample requested by the client to be dispatched and delivered to the nominated receiver on the same day

Shipping Samples means the composite pre and/or post shipment sample.

Weight Surcharge has the meaning as per attachment 1, A4 weight).

WPP Woven Polypropylene Bags.

2026/27 Schedule 1, Attachment 1 - Packing & processing charges

Explanatory notes

A. Containerisation

A1. Containerisation Farmer Dressed (FD) Bulk

The Containerisation Farmer Dressed (FD) Bulk Rate (Rate) is payable in relation to all FD Bulk packing services at the relevant Bunge Facility. The Rate is payable by the Client at the completion of packing. The Rate includes the following Services.

- Movement of empty containers from empty container park to the Bunge Facility as detailed in section D;
- Movement of loaded containers from the Bunge Facility to the Container Terminal as detailed in section D;
- Supply and fitting of false bulk heads;
- Performance of Road "Chain of Responsibility" mass management and fatigue management procedures and requirements;
- Wharf documentation and time slotting;
- Full weight documentation;
- Full shipment and inventory recording and reporting;
- Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry Container Approval Record (Empty Container Inspection);
- Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry Export Compliance Record (Commodity Inspection).

The rate is based on the average packed container weight per consignment, specifically greater than; 24mt for Wheat; 22mt for Barley; 20mt for Canola; 24mt for Sorghum and 24mt for Pulses. Where the density of the product or client requirements reduce the shipments average container packed weight below these minimum weights, a surcharge will apply as per the following

- $\text{Weight Surcharge} = \text{Min weight} \times \text{Listed Price} / \text{Average packed less Listed Price}$

A2. Fuel Surcharge

The Fuel Surcharge component will be:

- On-charged; and
- adjusted on a monthly basis;

Bunge will advise the Client at the earliest possible opportunity of the actual Fuel Surcharge for the following month payable by the Client.

A3. Infrastructure Surcharge

The Infrastructure Surcharge component will be:

- On-charged; and
- adjusted by the wharf operators;

Bunge will provide the Client with reasonable notice should the Infrastructure Surcharge require adjusting.

A4. Fumigation

The Fumigation Rate is applicable if Bunge provides a fumigation service when a Storage and Handling (including Third Party) fumigation certificate is not supplied or does not meet the Import Permit requirements. (Agreed to by Bunge pursuant to the 2026/27 Packing & Processing Agreement).

The Client acknowledges that those Services may be provided by Bunge or a contractor of Bunge. Bunge is only obliged to provide a fumigation certificate if:

- *Bunge fumigates the Grain as part of the Services provided under this Agreement; or*
- *A third party treatment certificate is provided prior to Bunge performing the Packing Services.*

If a third party treatment certificate is provided then the Client acknowledges and agrees that Bunge does not warrant, guarantee, make any representations in relation to, or assume any duty of care with respect to, the completeness, accuracy or adequacy of any information contained in the third party treatment certificate.

A5. Containerisation Bagged

The Containerisation Bagged Rate (Rate) is payable in relation to all Containerisation Bagged packing services at the relevant Bunge Facility. The Rate is payable by the Client at the completion of packing. The Rate includes the following Services.

- Movement of empty containers from Melbourne, to the Bunge Facility;
- Movement of loaded containers from the Bunge Facility to the Melbourne Container Terminal;
- Supply of WPP bags, printed on one side in one colour;
- Performance of Road "Chain of Responsibility" mass management and fatigue management procedures and requirements;
- Wharf documentation and time slotting;
- Full weight documentation;
- Full shipment and inventory recording and reporting;
- Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry Container Approval Record (Empty Container Inspection);
- Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry Export Compliance Record (Commodity Inspection)

A6. Additional Shipping Costs

The Additional Shipping Costs are applicable if requested on the Clients Packing Instructions.

- Shipping Sample charge is applicable per sample, including any additional samples requested post packing;
- Same Day Sample charge is applicable per sample for any samples requested by the Client to be dispatched and received by the nominated receiver on the same day;
- Re-PRA charge is applicable per container for any changes that the Client requests to be made to the PRA information after Bunge has successfully submitted the PRA;
- Food Quality (FQ) containers are the minimum requirement for exporting food products from Australia. Sites will not pack any containers that are not deemed as "Fit for Purpose" by our AO's.

Limited General Purpose containers (GP) upgrading services are available when no FQ container stock is available. Exporters intending on using GP containers only must clearly request the use GP containers at the time lodging their Packing Instruction.

Container Release MUST be open/ active no less than 12 days prior to cut off & ALL GP containers will incur the below relevant costs.

Shipments requesting the use GP containers may not be accepted due to limited availability and site selection.

- Container Liner charge is applicable per container and includes the supply and installation of the liner;
- Rejected container charge is applicable following the rejection of an empty container by an AO or for any cancelled or reduced shipments where the empty container is unable to be reallocated to another order. This charge is plus applicable months fuel surcharge.

B. Receival, Outturn, Storage and Shrinkage

B1. Receival

The Receival Fee is payable by the Client at the time of receival.

B2. Domestic Outturn

The Domestic Outturn Fee is applicable on all domestic outturns.

B3. Storage

Storage Fees are calculated based on stock on hand as at the first day of each month. Storage fees will be waived for the month of delivery. Monthly storage will apply for every subsequent calendar month (or part month) until either packed into Containers or Outturned.

B4. Shrinkage

A shrinkage factor will be deducted from each load of Grain at the time of initial delivery into the Bunge Facility. The factor applied is dependent on the receival type. Shrinkage will be capped as follows:

- 0.75% cap for Grains and loss of any Grain
- 1.0% cap for Pulses and loss of any Pulses

C. Additional Services

C1. Grain Cleaning

Contract Grain Cleaning is available on request. All losses will be to the Clients account. Grain Cleaning is subject to availability at the Bunge Facility.

C2. Grower Fumigation

Grower Fumigation on rejected loads is available on request. Grower Fumigation is subject to availability at the Bunge Facility.

D. Facility Specific Terms

D1. Dooen

A Client must execute the 2026/27 Bunge Storage and Handling Agreement in order to use the services under this agreement.

Empty containers to be collected primarily from ACFS E-Rail Melbourne, with alternate metropolitan empty container parks and terminals available should ACFS E-Rail not be able to fulfil release.

Loaded containers to be delivered to DP World and Patricks Swanston Terminal's and VICT Webb Dock.

D2. Pt Adelaide

A Client must execute the 2026/27 Bunge Storage and Handling Agreement in order to use the services under this agreement.

Empty containers to be collected from Adelaide metropolitan empty container parks and terminals.

Loaded containers to be delivered to Flinders Terminal Outer Harbor

D3. Ardrossan

A Client must execute the 2026/27 Bunge Storage and Handling Agreement in order to use the services under this agreement.

Empty containers to be collected from Adelaide metropolitan empty container parks and terminals.

Loaded containers to be delivered to Flinders Terminal Outer Harbor.
