

# Storage and handling fees

## 2026/27 season

Storage and handling service fees are paid by our buyer customers, and it is at their discretion how they reflect our cost-based charging structure in their site based pricing to farmer customers.

If grain is not sold to a buyer and is instead domestically outturned, the farmer is responsible for the domestic outturn fee and any storage and handling fees accumulated during the time in storage.

Differences in commodities reflect the costs associated with receiving, segregating, storing and handling them.

### Receival fee

This receival fee is payable in relation to all grains received directly from farmers into Bunge sites.

Note – Ardrossan and Port Pirie are deemed upcountry receival sites for the purposes of this fee.

### Monthly storage fee

Storage fees are waived for the month of delivery. For farmers' warehoused grain, storage fees are also waived for the month following the month of delivery. Monthly storage will apply for every subsequent calendar month (or part month) that the grain remains in storage.

Monthly storage fees accrue on a cumulative basis (after period when storage fee is waived), and are levied per tonne of grain in storage (as at the 1st of each month). The buyer will be charged warehouse's accumulated storage fees for all transfers in store.

## Additional monthly port storage fee

This fee is applicable to all farmer deliveries direct to Bunge port terminals. The monthly port storage fee is payable in addition to monthly storage fees.

## Definitions

In this Schedule, unless the context otherwise requires:

**Cereals** means wheat, barley oats, triticale, cereal rye and sorghum.

**Canola** means CAGM and CANO

**Pulses** means chickpeas, lupins, peas, faba beans, lentils, vetch, broad beans and all other grain legumes.
